Lincoln Bicentennial Concert Will Feature "Lincoln Portrait" Narrated by Congressman Brad Ellsworth

LINCOLN CITY, IND. ---- The finale of Spencer County's Lincoln Bicentennial celebration will take place at Lincoln Amphitheatre on Sunday, September 6 at 7:30 p.m. CDT. Congressman Brad Ellsworth will make a special appearance and WFIE Chief Meteorologist Jeff Lyons will serve as Master of Ceremonies.

The audience at Lincoln Amphitheatre will hear the Evansville Philharmonic, under the baton of Alfred Savia, play some of America's most beloved music. The program includes Aaron Copland's *Fanfare for the Common Man* and *A Lincoln Portrait* narrated by Congressman Ellsworth, as well as *God Bless America*, Melodies of Stephen Foster, and Tchaikovsky's 1812 Overture complete with cannons from the Indiana National Guard 1st Battalion, 163rd Artillery "The Nighthawks".
